Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Bessie B. Roy, who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is Bessie B. Roy. I am seventy years old and live at Helena, Alabama. I am the widow of M. E. Roy who died March 23, 1960.

I have been familiar with the possession and ownership of the following described property since 1923 and until the present date.

Part of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22 Township 20 South, Range 3 West, described as follows: Commence at the NW corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 22 and run South along West line of said Quarter-Quarter Section a distance of 115.40 feet; thence turn angle of 70 deg. 00 min. to left and run a distance of 19.0 feet to point of beginning; thence continue in same direction a distance of 80.60 feet; thence turn an angle of 3 deg. 10 min. to left and run a distance of 166.70 feet; thence turn an angle of 73 deg. 10 min. to right and run South parallel with West line of said Quarter-Quarter Section a distance of 168.00 feet to North margin of gravel road; thence turn an angle of 120 deg. 30 min. to right and run along the North margin of said road a distance of 84.9 feet; thence turn an angle of 23 deg. 42 min. to left and run along the North margin of said road a distance of 163.25 feet; thence turn an angle of 83 deg. 12 min. to right and run North and parallel with West line of said Quarter-Quarter Section a distance of 181.42 feet to point of beginning.

I have been informed that my husband formerly owned this property and that my husband and I conveyed said property, as a part of a larger tract, to J. A. Thompson in 1919. I do not remember making this conveyance, as my husband acquired said property prior to our marriage. My husband and I moved to Helena from Clanton about 1923, and I do remember that J. A. Thompson owned and possessed said property at that time in 1923.

After Mr. J. A. Thompson and his wife died about 1938, said property was sold by the Thompson heirs to Ross Wilson sometime later, Ross Wilson owned and possessed said property until he sold the same to Alfred Lambert about 1947.

During the time that I have been familiar with the possession and ownership of this property I have lived in the vicinity of the subject property and I have never heard anyone question the title of Alfred Lambert and his predecessors in title noted above. I know of my own personal knowledge that Alfred Lambert and his

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predecessors in title have, since 1923 and until the present date, been in a peaceable, open, notorious, continuous, undisturbed, adverse possession of all of said property claiming to own the same against the claims of all persons whatsoever.
