That she is 63 years of age, having been born January 9, 1897, and has been a resident of either Shelby or Jefferson Counties all her life, living in or near Leeds, Jefferson County, Alabama, or in or near Dunnivant, Shelby County, Alabama, in which last named place she was for many years postmistress.

That she is the one and same person variously known as Vera Lee, Vera Lee Whitehead, Mrs. Frances Whitehead, Mrs. F. E. Whitehead, Vera D. Lee Whitehead, and Vera DeLoach Lee Whitehead, and Vera D. Whitehead.

That she was the second wife of Francis Ernest Whitehead; that the said Francis Ernest Whitehead was formerly married about the year 1910 to his first wife who died very shortly afterwards without issue, and that afterwards he married affiant; that the said Francis Ernest Whitehead died intestate on May 27, 1936, and left surviving him as sole heirs, his wife, this affiant, the said Vera DeLoach Lee Whitehead, and a son, Frank William Whitehead, and no other child, or any children of another child.
