I, Frank G. Brewer, of Birmingham, Alabama, being over the age of twenty-one years, of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament as follows:

ITEM I.

I hereby revoke all former testamentary dispositions by me made.

ITEM II.

I direct my Executor hereinafter named to pay all of my just debts and funeral expenses and the expenses of my last illness and of the administration of my estate and all taxes legally chargeable against my estate, as soon after my death as conveniently may be.

ITEM III.

After the above payments and bequests, all of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate and property both real, personal and mixed, wherever situated and however held, over which I may have any power of testamentary disposition at the time of my death, shall be divided as follows:

30% thereof to my beloved son, Frank, Jr., if he survives me.

30% thereof to my beloved son, Donald, if he survives me.

20% thereof to my beloved daughter, Lela Anne if she survives me.

20% thereof to my beloved daughter, Mary Jane Brewer Tarrant, if she survives me.

In the event that any of my said children predecease me leaving surviving them and me, a child or children, then such child or children shall take in equal shares the same share of my estate which their parent would have taken if living. If any of my children predecease me leaving no

children surviving them and me, then the share of such deceased child of mine shall be equally divided among my surviving children or their descendants.

I have already made other provisions for my beloved wife, Nina, and for that reason I have not named her as beneficiary of this will. Other benefits have been arranged for my two daughters and the fact that they do not share equally with my sons under the terms hereof does not indicate that I feel any less affection for them than I do for my sons.

ITEM IV.

I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my son Frank, Jr., as Executor of this my last will and testament and I waive the giving of any bond or security by him as such, and waive the filing of any inventory or appraisal by him as such in any court. I authorize my Executor in making division or distribution of my estate in accordance with the provisions hereof to make the same wholly or partly in kind and at such valuations as to him, in his sole discretion, seems fair and proper. In the event that my said son predeceases me, dies, resigns, or for any other reason fails or refuses to act as such Executor, then I nominate constitute, and appoint my daughter, Lela Ann, as successor Executrix with all of the rights, powers and duties hereinabove set out as applicable to my said son as Executor.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the undersigned Frank G. Brewer, have hereunto set my signature and seal, on this the 6 day of April, 1957., at Birmingham, Alabama, hereby declaring the above and foregoing instrument contained on this and the preceding page, each of which has been signed by me, to be my last will and testament.

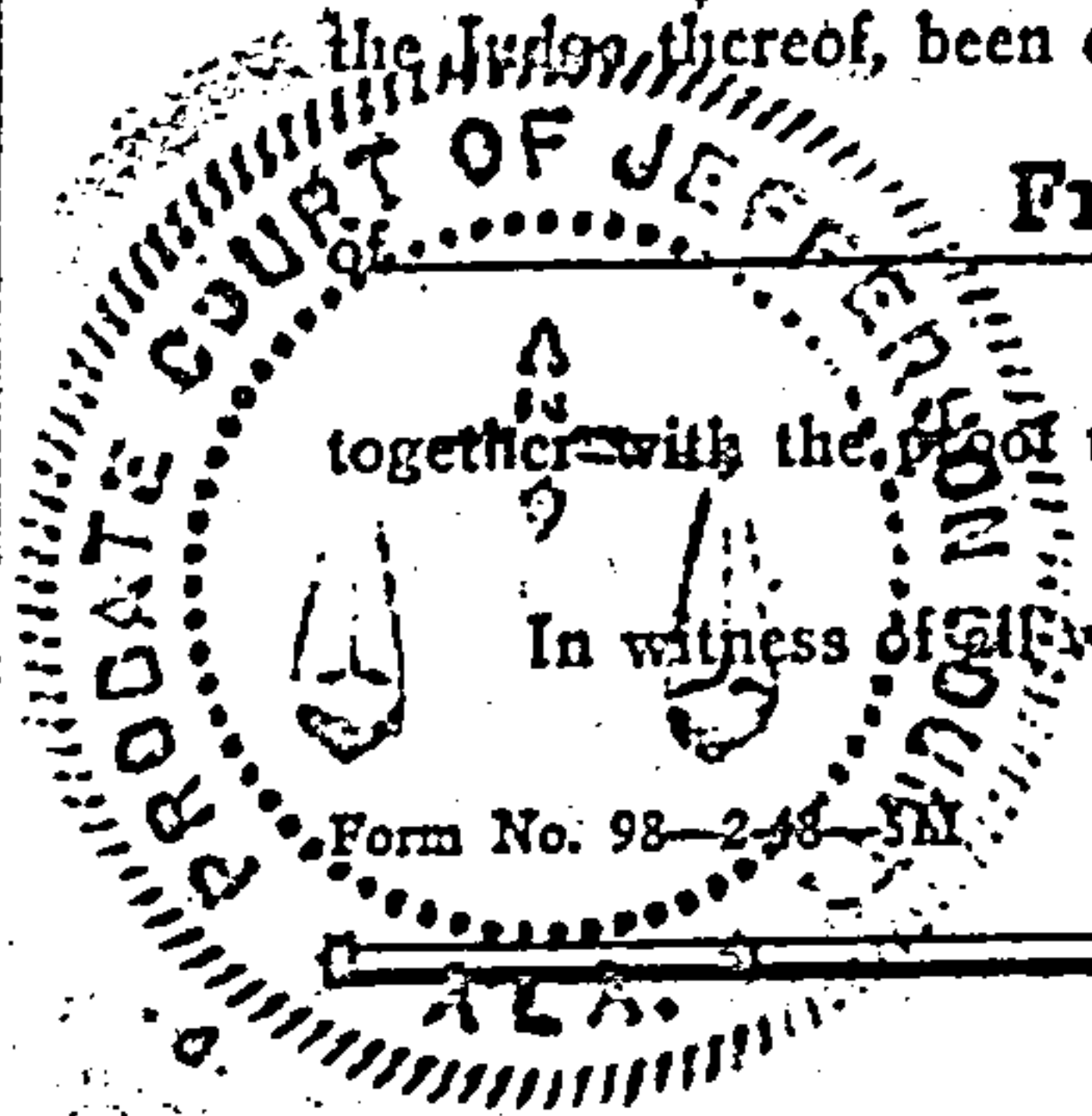
