the South West quarter of the North West quarter of Section one in Township twenty one of Range one East in the District of Lands subject to sale at Pensacola Alabama containing thirty nine acres and ninety eight and a half hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Sampson Holland*

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said

Sampson Holland

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
