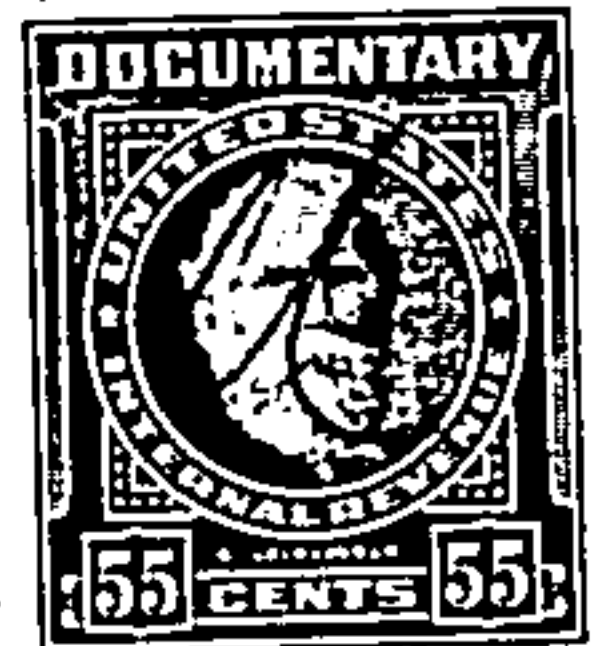

by that certain warranty deed dated April 1, 1938, and which deed was executed by J. T. 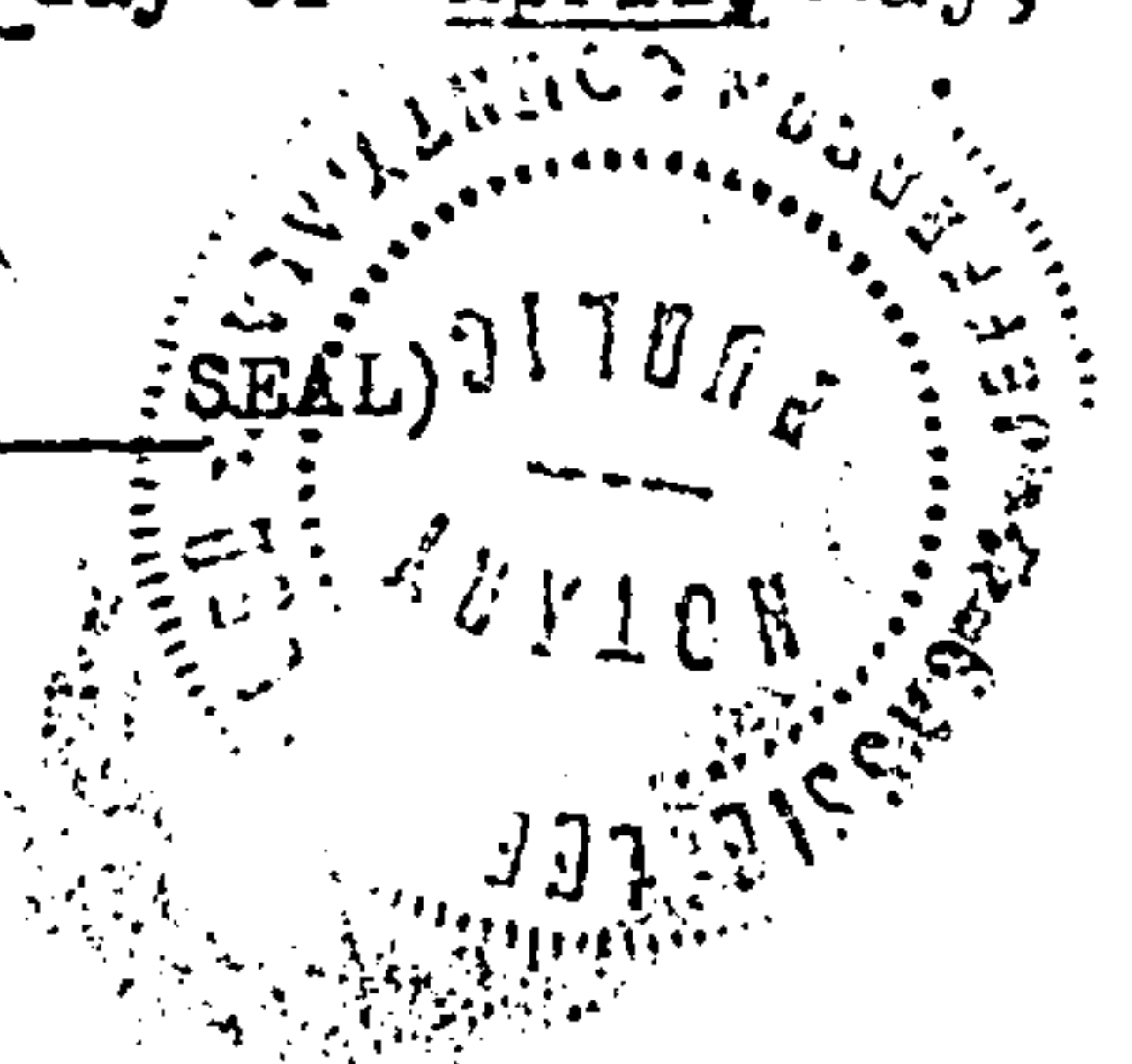
