

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF
ROSALIE WEAVER

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I, ROSALIE WEAVER, a resident of Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and aware of the uncertainty of the continuance of life, do hereby make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all wills and testaments heretofore executed by me.

1. It is my will that all of my just debts, including the expenses of my last illness and my funeral and burial expenses be paid as soon after my death as the prudent and orderly administration of my estate will permit.

2. All of the rest, residue and remainder of my property of every kind and character whatsoever, wheresoever situated, both real, personal or mixed, I hereby give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved mother, Annie E. Weaver, if she survives me; but if my beloved mother does not survive me, then I hereby give, devise and bequeath the same unto my brothers and sisters, share and share alike provided that if any brother or sister of mine fails to survive me and leaves surviving him or her a lawful descendant or descendants, the descendants of such deceased brother or sister shall take the decedent's share in equal shares per stirpes and not per capita.

3. I hereby appoint my beloved brother, Graves H. Weaver, Jr., as Executor of this my last will and testament, if living, but if he be not living, I hereby constitute and appoint my nephew, C. H. Chichester, Jr., as Executor, and direct that neither shall be required to give any bond to insure the faithful performance of his duties. My Executor shall have power to compromise and adjust claims owned by my estate. He shall have power to sell and convey any assets of my estate, to lease any real property upon such terms as to him shall seem to be advisable for any period of time, whether less or greater than the period of administra-

tion, shall have power to enter into extension agreements with respect to any mortgages owned by me or owed by me, or he may pay any such mortgage or any part thereof in his sole discretion. In the event that my mother does not survive me, he is empowered to divide my estate, either in cash or in kind, and execute such transfers and conveyances and sales as may be necessary to effectuate a division thereof. He may repair and improve real estate, insure the same against such hazards as he deems to be advisable, employ Counsel and rely upon the advice of Counsel, and have and recover from my estate all expenses reasonably incurred in connection with the duties and powers herein granted and imposed.
