and the description of said chattel(s) is incorporated herein by reference; and

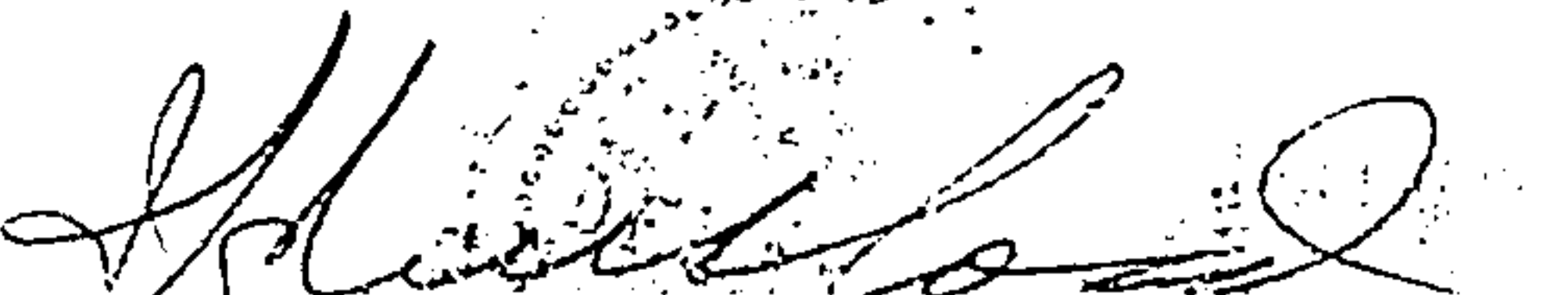
WHEREAS, the entire indebtedness for which said Chattel Mortgage was given as security has been fully paid and satisfied;

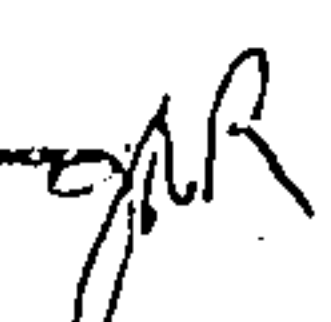
