Pool of 1807 Oxmoor Road, Homewood, Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory and being mindful of the certainty of death and of the uncertainty of life, do hereby make and publish this, my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills, if any, by me at any time made, viz:

ITEM ONE: It is my will that all of my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my death as practicable.

ITEM TWO: I will, devise, and bequeath to my wife, Bertha Pool, all my life insurance and all my United States Government bonds, or other bonds that I may own at the time of my death.

ITEM THREE: I will, devise, and bequeath to my three children, Naomi Pool Regan, Charlie A. Pool, and Paul A. Pool, share and share alike, all of the real estate of which I may die seized and possessed or to which I may be entitled in equity at the time of my death.

ITEM FOUR: I will, devise, and bequeath to my three children above named, share and share alike, all farm equipment and personal property I own at the time of my death except my bonds, insurance, and money in the bank.

ITEM FIVE: I hereby nominate and appoint my daughter, Naomi Pool Regan, as Executrix of this will without bond and without the necessity of accounting to any court for her actions as such.
