

Last Will and Testament 34616

OF

ROSE OWEN

WIT
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I, Rose Owen, a resident citizen of Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this instrument as and for my last will and testament, hereby expressly revoking any and all former wills by me made.

ITEM ONE: I direct that all of my just debts including the expenses of my last illness and funeral be paid by my personal representative as soon after my death as may be convenient.

ITEM TWO: I hereby give and grant unto my personal representative hereinafter named full power and authority to sell and convey any property which I may own at the time of my death at public or private sale without order of court and upon such terms and conditions and for such amounts as said representative may deem proper.

ITEM THREE: I hereby give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved husband, William Monte Owen, all the rest and residue of my property, real, personal or mixed, which I may own or to which I may be entitled at the time of my death or to which my estate may become entitled after my death, or over which I may have any power of disposition. I direct that this bequest and devise shall be effective against children now unborn as well as against our child, William Monte Owen, Jr., now living. I make this provision being convinced that my said husband will provide for the support and education of any children surviving me and will handle and dispose of my estate to the best of his ability and to the best interest of such children.

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ITEM FOUR: In the event that my said husband is not living at the time of my death or dies with me in a common accident or calamity, or under circumstances casting doubt as to whether he survived me, then I give, devise and bequeath all of my said property to any children surviving me, share and share alike, and in such event I hereby appoint my sister, Lottie Page, as guardian of the property and estate of any child surviving me who, at the time of my death may be under legal age. I expressly authorize and empower said guardian in her sole discretion to expend any part of the share of such minor child including either corpus or income for the support or education of such child without obtaining an order of any court having jurisdiction of said guardianship. I hereby expressly exempt said guardian from giving any bond as such. I further expressly authorize said guardian to exercise any settlement options under any insurance policies on my life payable to any such minor child without order of any court.

ITEM FIVE: I constitute and appoint my said husband, William Monte Owen, as executor of this my last will and testament and direct that my said executor shall not be required to give bond as such or make any report or furnish any inventory to any court. In the event that my said husband does not survive me or in the event that he fails or ceases for any cause to serve as such executor, then I nominate and appoint my sister, Lottie Page, as executrix of this will and I also direct that she shall not be required to give bond or make any report to any court.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and seal on this the 28th day of October, 1950, hereby

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declaring the instrument contained on this and the two preceding pages to be my last will and testament.
