has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Washington in accordance

whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Shelby County

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the East half of the South East quarter of Section thirty five in Township twenty one of Range three (west) in the District of Columbia and part of Williams containing Eighty five acres and fifty one hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Shelby County

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the sum of one hundred and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Shelby County and to their heirs and assigns forever the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Shelby County and to their heirs and assigns forever.
