Personally came and appeared before the undersigned authority, a Notary Public in and for said County in said State, Charley Glass, who, after being first by me duly sworn to speak the truth, deposeth and says:

My anme is Charley Glass, and I am 61 years of age, and have lived in Calera, Shelby County, Alabama, all of my lifetime. I have lived on Lots No. 6, 8 and 9 of Block 10, according to J. H. Dunstan's survey of Calera, Alabama, and since the year 1916, and presently reside on Lot No. 6. Block 10.

I can remember when John Glass, in the year 1920, purchased the Niz of Lots 10 and 11 in Block 10, and Walter Glass purchased the S% of Lots 8 and 9 in Block 10, according to J. H. Dunstan's map, from Mrs. F. Stein, a widow.

I have the original deeds in my possession, which are recorded in Deed Book 28 at page 506, in the Office of Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama, wherein F. Stein purchased the old Oakley Hotel lot in the Town of Calera, from J. L. Peters, in the year 1903.

I know that now the lots are known, according to J. H. Dunstan's map, as follows:

The S½ of what was referred to as Lots 10 and 11, is actually Lots 8 and 9, and the N½ is actually Lots 10 and 11 of Block No. 10 of Dunstan's map, and these four lots are known as the old Oakley Hotel Lot.

In the year 1920, when Walter Glass acquired title to the S% of the Oakley Hotel Lot, which is lots B and 9 in Block, by deed dated February 25, 1920, and recorded in Deed Book 115 at page 16, and John Glass, on the same date took his deed to the N½ of the Oakley Hotel Lot, which is actually Lots 10 and 11 in Block 10 of Dunstan's map, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 67 at page 114. That John Glass was in possession of the house situated on both lots 10 and 11 as a tenant of Mrs. F. Stein, widow of the F. Stein referred to in the deed above, and Walter Glass was living in the house situated on both Lots 8 and 9, as a tenant of Mrs. F. Stein, and

and Walter Glass is my brother, and our father's name is Calvin Glass, and we all lived in the house situated on Lots 8 and 9, and I lived in this house with my parents until the year 1927, when I bought Lots 6 and 7 of Block 10, and moved into a house situated on Lot 6, and I presently own Lots 6 and 7, and have lived there on Lot 6 since the year 1927.

Ever since I can remember, there has been a fence separating Lots 10 and 11 from Lots 8 and 9.

The house situated on both Lots 10 and 11 was torn down by Mr. Robert Holcombe while he owned the property, and Robert Holcombe built another house on Lot 10, and after my brother, Walter Jackson Glass, bought Lots 10 and ll, he sold to Charles Glass, Jr. and wife Burnece L. Glass, in 1953, Lot 11 in Block 10, and Charles Glass, Jr. and his wife built a house on Lot 11 and moved into said house, and have been living on said property since the completion of the house in the year 1954.

Since the year 1920, I have never known of W. H. Martin, Mary Martin, M. E. Johnson, Mary M. Johnson, or Blanche Sorrell claiming any interest or title to Lot 11 in Block 10, according to J. H. Dunstan's Map of Calera, Alabama.

I know of my own personal knowledge that since the purchase by John Blass from Mrs. F. Stein, by deed recorded in Deed Book 67 at page 114, dated February 25, 1920, and his successors in title, that the possession of the said John Glass and his successors in title, has been continuous, exclusive, peaceful, quiet, notorious, direct, adverse and hostile and under color of title and claim of ownership since February 25, 1920, and since that time no one has been in possession of any part of said property claiming adverse to said owners, nor has affiant known of anyone, and especially Blanche Sorrell, claiming any right, title or interest in or to said property, adverse to said owners, nor has he ever heard anyone dispute or question the title of said owners to said lands.
