My name is E. S. Pearson. I am 73 years of age and have lived in and near the property described in the foregoing affidavit of A. B. Bristow all of my life. Affiant further says he has read the affidavit made by A. B. Bristow dated February 6, 1961, and he knows the same is true and correct. In fact, he is familiar with the matters and things mentioned by Mr. Bristow. Affiant further says that several years before Alexander Worthy sold the land to W. P. Eason, Alexander Worthy contracted to sell the above described land, along with other land to North Evans and he was to pay 100 bales of cotton for it. Mr. Evans went into possession of the property and paid on it two or three years and the price of cotton went up and he quit paying on it and abandoned the place and it is affiant's information that no deed was ever made to him. It is affiant's recollection that this was around 1900 and affiant has never heard of North Evans since.
