3. R. E. Powers, and wife, Lily Powers, dated May 7, 1940, recorded in Deed Book 108, page 377, in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.
4. R. E. Powers, an unmarried man, dated March 23, 1937, recorded in Deed Book 102, page 396, in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

The purpose for which such right of way permits were acquired was for such distribution poles, wires and appliances as are now in place on the property described in such permits.
