and says as follows:

I am a son of Richard H. Brasher to whom T. A. Adams
and wife conveyed the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 18,
Range 1E, Shelby County, Alabama, by deed dated December 12, 1892
and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in
Deed Book 214 at Page 559 et seq. I am also one of the grantors in
that certain deed from the heirs of R. H. Brasher and wife, Mary
Elizabeth Brasher, conveying said property and other property to
W. I. Rich and S. M. Smith, which said deed is dated March 25,
1958 and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama,
in Deed Book 193 at Page 427.

My said father, R. H. Brasher, and my mother, Mary Eliza-
beth Brasher, both resided in Shelby County and they died there
and are buried near the above described property. My father died
on March 29, 1913 and my mother died on March 8, 1957.
Neither my father nor mother left any will and there has been no
