My name is Karl C. Harrison. I am a practicing attorney at the Columbiana, Bar. I wrote to the Ad Valorem Tax Division of the State Department of Revenue in Montgomery regarding a Tax Sale in the name of M. A. White made on July 11, 1914, conveying a one-third interest in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 24, Range 15 East. I further certify that on May 17, 1961, I was advised by said Department that they did not find a record of the above Tax Sale. I have also checked the Tax Sale Record in the Probate Office here at Columbiana, being Tax Sale Record 4 page 331, and the record shows there as a tax sale in the name M. A. White, but the same does not show to whom the property was sold. It appears that the State's name was originally on the record as the purchaser, but the name has been stricken thereon.
