## RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED FOR PUBLIC ROAD

STATE OF ALABAMA. Shelby .County KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, \_\_\_\_ and wife \_\_\_\_\_of the County and State aforesaid, in and for the consideration of one dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid by Shelby County the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and for the further consideration of the benefit accruing to us and to the public from the construction or improvement of a public road through our lands, Shelby County, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey Shelby County, its successors or assigns, a Right-of-Way hereihafter described, over and across our said lands in Shelby County, Ala., for a public road; which right-of-way shall be - soc below in width on \_\_\_\_\_ side of the center line of said road, as it is now located and staked out by the State Highway Department or as much of our lands as is required to make a \_\_\_\_\_ foot right-of-way across our lands, said right-of-way herein conveyed being more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the centerline of Project SACP 4391-A at Station 61+00, the west property line; thence east along the north property line, which is the section line between Sec. 10 and Sec. 15, a distance of approximately 390° to a point on the north property line approximately 15° left of Station 64+88; thence south along the east property line a distance of 55' to a point on the south 40' right of way line; thence along said south right of way line N 89° 08' W a distance of 300" to a point on the west property line; thence north along the west property line a distance of 40' to the point of beginning. Said strip of land is lying in the NE4 of NW4, Sec. 15, T 21 S, R 3 W and contains 0.48 acres, more or less, including that part now occupied by the present road. An easement is granted of sufficient length and width to provide inlet and cutlet ditches to properly dispose of drainage. In deep cuts and high fills where the top of the back slopes and the toe of the fill slopes respectively should exceed the right of way width as shown above, then an easement is granted to allow this additional construction space. The unused part of said right of way will be used by Shelby County to dispose of trees, roots, stumps and other refuse where necessary.
