the North & South line that divides the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of

 $\frac{1}{2}$ of the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 4, that lies west of said creek
that part of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 4, that lies west of the Creek & south
of the line described above, that part of the west half of SE $\frac{1}{4}$
of section 4, that lies south of said line & the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ &
