On March 23. 1915 my brother G. G. Mullins, and I purchased the above described property from Oscar L. McLaughlin and wife, Celia McLaughlin. We were referred to as the grantees in that deed as "Mullins Brothers". The said "Mullins Brothers" referred only to myself and my brother, G. G. Mullins.

Subsequently, on February 23, 1916 I conveyed all of my right, title and interest in said property to my said brother, G. G. Mullins, and thereafter claimed no further interest to the said property.

I do not now and I never have since conveying to my brother G. G. Mullins in February, 1916 claimed any interest whatsoever in said above described property.

My said brother was also known as Gwin G. Mullins, and at the time of his death in the year 1949 was married to Vera Mullins.
