I, Iris A. Johnson, of Dora, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do make this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills at any time heretofore made by me.

1. I give, devise and bequeath to my husband, Joe G. Johnson, all the property, real, personal and mixed, of which I may die seized and possessed, or to which I may be entitled at the time of my death.

2. I give, devise and bequeath to my husband, Joe G. Johnson, all of the insurance that may be on my life and which may be payable to my estate at the time of my death, and authorize that such insurance be paid to him and be his absolutely.

3. It is my desire and I will that Joe G. Johnson have absolute authority and control over all of my property, and that same shall be his as above set forth at my death, and he shall not be held accountable to anyone for the disposition of such property; that he shall handle the property left by me as he may desire, with full power to sell, lease, exchange or reinvest any or all property as he may see proper, and he shall have such power without obtaining any authority or order from any court.

4. It is my desire that my estate, so far as can be done, be kept out of court, and that my husband, Joe G. Johnson, be not required to make any inventory or reports of any act which he may do with reference to my property, I having full confidence in his honesty, integrity and ability to handle such property without authority from anyone or from any court.

5. I nominate and appoint my husband ^{Joe G. Johnson} as executor of this my last will and testament and declare that he shall not be required to give any bond for the performance of any and all duties arising hereunder; nor shall he be required to make any inventory

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of any and all property coming into his hands as such executor;
nor make any report to any court of his proceedings with reference
to the disposition of the said property under this will.

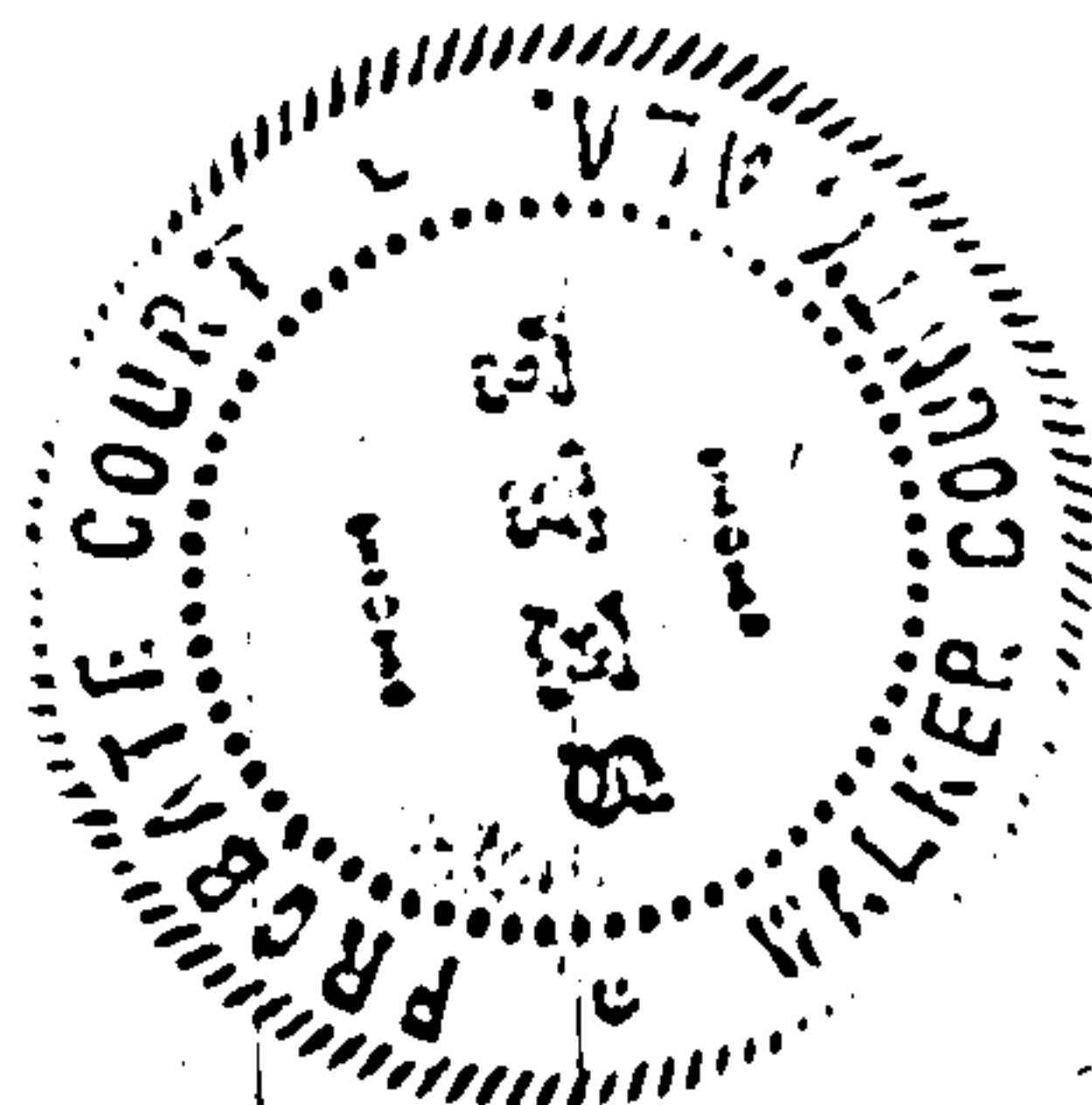
