

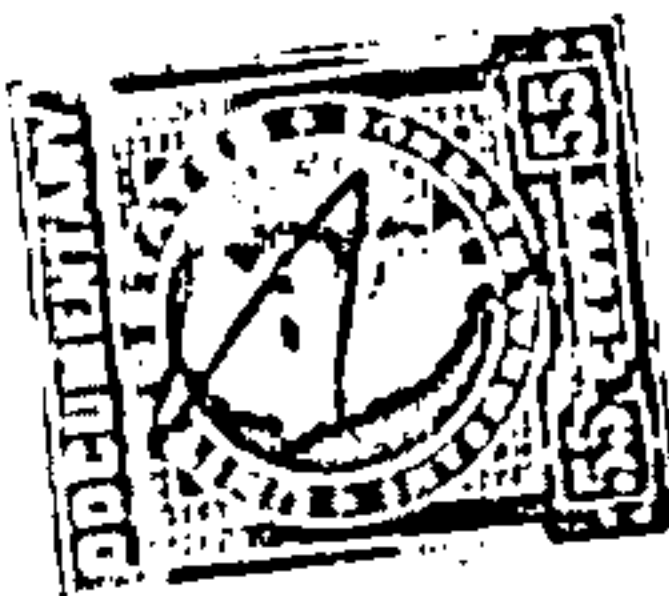

All lots have a 30 foot building line from the street and a 7 foot
sideline clearance. An easement of 3 feet on each side of all lot
lines for public utilities shall be reserved and no buildings to
be located thereon. No structures of a temporary nature such as
trailers, tents, shacks, basements, garages or other outbuildings
shall be used as a residence, either temporarily or permanently,
