This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confession, and

Answer and Waiver, Agreement and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said Bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Respondent be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said

Complainant, Forrel V. Smith,

is forever divorced from the said Stanley Smith

for and on account of Adultery

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the respondent pay to the complainant Eight and No/100 dollars each week for her support and maintenance so long as he is gainfully employed and is physically able to work.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that in the event the respondent should sell the dwelling house now occupied by him he shall pay to the complainant one half of the proceeds of such sale, and, in the event the respondent should die before the complainant, the complainant shall receive title in fee simple to such dwelling house.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that Forrel V. Smith and Stanley Smith be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Stanley Smith the respondent pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.
