




MORTGAGE FORECLOSURE DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, WHEREAS,
heretofore on to-wit: November 4, 1960
Leroy Donahue and wife, Jean Donahue
executed a mortgage to H. W. Richards Lumber Company,
a Corp. on the property hereinafter described, and
which said mortgage is recorded in Mortgage Book 269 at Page 150
Probate Office, Shelby County, Alabama;



WHEREAS, in and by said mortgage the mortgagee was
authorized and empowered in case of default in the payment of
