

RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF One Hundred Sixty Five & No/100- ---- DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Norman R. Brasher and Jewel M. Brasher his wife and
H. Brasher and Margaret Brasher his wife, & Paul L. Yeager and Willie B. Yeager

Morris Brasher and Boyd Brasher his wife, and Ralph Sorrell and Bonnie
Sorrell his wife, and Alyce Brasher a widow, Pelham, Alabama.

South Half of Northwest Quarter (S) of NW₄) of Section 21, Township

20 South, Range 2 West, situated in the County of Shelby, State of

Alabama.



together with the right of unimpaired access to said pipeline and the right of ingress and egress on, over, and through the above-described land for any and all purposes necessary and incident to the exercise by said Grantee of the rights granted hereunder.

The said Grantors shall have the right to use and enjoy the above-described land except as the same may be necessary for the purposes herein granted to the said Grantee. Grantors agree not to build, create, or construct any obstructions, engineering works, or other structures over said pipe line nor permit the same to be done by others.

In addition to the above consideration, Grantee agrees to repair or to pay for any actual damage which may be done to growing crops, timber, fences, buildings, or other structures directly caused by Grantee exercising any rights herein granted.

Any pipe line constructed by Grantee across any portion of the above-described land which is under cultivation shall, at the time of the construction thereof, be buried to such depth as will not interfere with Grantors' use of said land for normal cultivation required for the planting and tending of crops; except that Grantee, at its option, may construct its pipe line above the channel of any natural or man-made stream, ravine, ditch, or other water course.

As part of the consideration hereunto set forth, Grantors hereby grant unto said Grantee, its successors and assigns the right at any time to construct, operate and maintain an additional pipeline or pipelines substantially parallel to the first pipeline constructed.

By Grantee on Grantors' behalf, above-described land Grantee agrees to pay Grantors the sum of \$ XXXXXX for each additional pipeline constructed, and payments to be made before construction commences. Said additional pipeline or pipelines shall be subject to the same rights, privileges and conditions as set forth in this Right of Way Easement.

It is agreed that any payment hereunder may be made direct to said Grantors, or any one of them, or by depositing such payment to

order of said Grantors, or any one of them, to the XXXXXX Bank at XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX. Such payment to bank shall be deemed and considered as payment to each of said Grantors.

The rights herein granted may be assigned in whole or in part.

The terms, conditions, and provisions of this right of way easement shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors, and assigns of the parties hereto.

It is understood and agreed that the right of way herein granted shall be 75 ft.
in width during the period of construction, and that after construction and
clean-up, then the said permanent right of way shall be 50 ft. in width, exten-
ing 35 ft. on the south side and 15 ft. on the north side of the center line
said pipe line then in place.
