Reference is made to Mr. Ray's letter of June 29, 1961, requesting a right of way for construction of a public road across land of this corporation in various sections in Townships 20 and 21 South, Ranges 3 and 4 Wast, Shalby County, Alabama, in connection with the above project.

This letter is written in duplicate and, when accepted as hereinofter provided, will constitute your authority to proceed with construction of said road upon the following terms and conditions:

- (1) That construction of said road shall be in accordance with plans submitted with said latter of June 29, 1961, and no substantial deviation shall be made therefrom without the prior written consent of this corporation.
- (2) That Shalby County shall indomnify and hold the United States Steel Corporation harmless from all loss, claim, or damage which may accrue by reason of the construction of said road upon land of the United States Steel Corporation.
- (3) That convoyance of the assement for said road shall be to the extent of our exnership and subject to existing essements for roads, railroads, pipe lines, electric power transmission lines, telephone lines, and other facilities.

- That Shalby County shall convoy to the United States (4) Steel Corporation ito interest in those portions of the existing road on property of the United States Stool Corporation which will be abandoned as a result of this now construction.
- (5) Timber on the right of way has been sold to J. T. McMillan under contract providing for cutting rights expiring on October 31, 1961, and the authority herein granted is subject to Mr. McMillan's right to cut and remove said timber and with the understanding that your operations hereunder shall not interfere therewith, and that you shall cut no timber located on said right of way except such as Mr. McMillan may elect not to cut in the course of his operations.
- (6) That after construction of said road has been completed, the United States Steel Corporation shall, at its empanse, make such surveys as it deems necessary to determine the location of said read as constructed and shall thereafter convey to Shelby County, without charge, the nacessary easement for said read. The United States Steal Corporation will reserve the right to install and maintain within the boundaries of the right of way for said assement electric power transmission lines, telephono lines, telegraph lines, pipe lines, railroad tracko, and roads or ways of any description either at, above, or balow grade, provided that the exercise of such rights chall not unreasonably interfere with said read.

If the above is satisfactory to you, please so indicate by having the acceptance of the County indicated in the space provided below and returning one copy of this lotter to us, after which this shall constitute a contrast between the United States Steel Corporation and Shelby County, Alabama.
