RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THREE HUNDRED FIFTY TWO AND NO/100 (\$352.00) DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, The Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama, a corporation, acting by and through its duly authorized Executive Committee, composed of John A. Caddell, as Chairman, and Thomas S. Lawson and Ernest G. Williams, as members thereof, hereinafter referred to as Grantor, does hereby grant and convey unto COLONIAL PIPELINE COMPANY, a Delaware Corporation, its successors and assigns, hereinafter referred to as Grantee, an easement for a pipeline right of way with the right to construct, maintain, inspect, operate, protect, repair, replace, change the size of, and remove one pipeline for the transportation of liquids and/or gases on, over, and through the following described lands, of which Grantor warrants it is the owner in fee simple, situated in Shelby County, State of Alabama, to-wit:

A strip of land 75 feet in width, extending 25 feet on the North side, and 50 feet on the South side, of the center line as shown on the attached plat marked Detail "A" and made a part of this instrument; said strip of land lying and being in Section 18, Township 21 South, Range 4 West; and containing 10.03 acres, more or less.

Together with the right of unimpaired access to said pipeline and the right of ingress and egress on, over, and through the above-described land for any and all purposes necessary and incident to the exercise by said Grantee of the rights granted hereunder.

The said Grantor shall have the right to use and enjoy the above-described land except as the same may be necessary for the purposes herein granted to the said Grantee, Grantor agrees not to build, create, or construct any obstructions, engineering works, or other structures over said pipe line nor permit the same to be done by others.

In addition to the above consideration, Grantee agrees to repair or to pay for any actual damage which may be done to growing crops, timber, fences, buildings, or other structures directly caused by Grantee exercising any rights herein granted.

Any pipe line constructed by Grantee across any portion of the above-described land which is under cultivation shall, at the time of the construction thereof, be buried to such depth as will not interfere with Grantor's use of said land for normal cultivation required for the planting and tending of crops; except that Grantee, at its option, may construct its pipe line above the channel of any natural or man-made stream, ravine, ditch, or other water course.

The terms, conditions, and provisions of this right of way easement shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors, and assigns of the parties hereto.

It is understood and agreed that the right of way herein granted shall be 75 feet in width during the period of construction, and that after construction and clean-up, then the said permanent right of way shall be 50 feet in width, extending 35 feet on the south side and 15 feet on the north side of the center line of said pipe line then in place.
