

WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

For Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other good and valuable consideration to the undersigned grantors Connie W. Wooten and his wife Agnes M. Wooten, and Lonnie Wooten and his wife Johnnie B. Wooten, and B. G. Parker and his wife Mary Parker in hand paid by Clyde Smith the receipt where of is acknowledged we the said Connie W. Wooten, Agnes M. Wooten, Lonnie Wooten, Johnnie B. Wooten, B. G. Parker, and Mary Parker do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said Clyde Smith the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Commence at the SE corner of the SW quarter of the NE quarter, Section 12, Township 24, Range 15 East and run West along the South line of said quarter quarter section for a distance of 750.4 feet to a point; thence turn South and run on a bearing of South 3°30' East for a distance of 328.4 feet to a point; thence turn left and run on a bearing of South 67°15' West for a distance of 54.4 feet; thence turn left and run on a bearing of 59°20' West for a distance of 58.1 feet; thence turn left and run on a bearing of South 46°20' West for a distance of 224.5 feet to a point; thence turn left and run on a bearing of South 3°30' East for a distance of 72.5 feet to the point of beginning of the land herein conveyed; thence from the point of beginning thus established continue in a straight line along the last above described course for a distance of 72.5 feet; thence turn left and run on a bearing of North 46°20' East for a distance of 75.0 feet; thence turn left and run on a bearing of North 3°30' East for a distance of 72.5 feet; thence turn left and run on a bearing of South 46°20' West for a distance of 75.0 feet to the point of beginning. The land herein conveyed is a parallelogram measuring 75.0 feet by 72.5 feet and is situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

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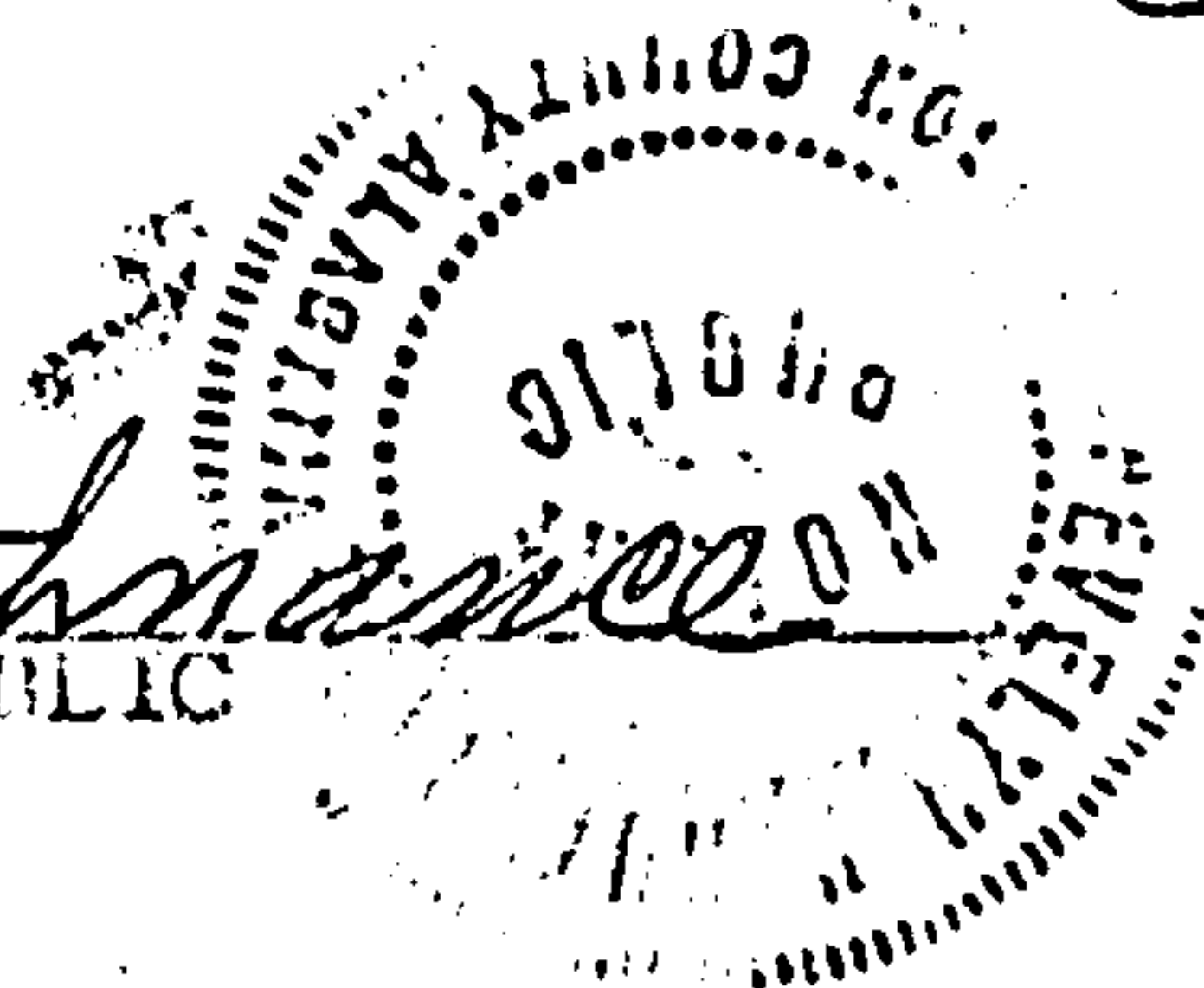
