KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That in consideration of ONE

do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said

Robert E. Jewell and Willie Mae Jewell

as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, the following described real estate, situated in

Shelby

County, Alabama, to-wit:

Commence at the southeast corner of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Township 19 South
Range 1 East and run thence north along the east line of said forty a distance of
190 feet to the northeast corner of a lot ^{and being point of beginning or} heretofore conveyed to the grantees; thence
continue north along said forty line a distance of 110 feet to the Nelson property;
thence run west along said Nelson property a distance of 105 feet; thence south and
parallel with the east line of said forty acres a distance of 110 feet to the north-
west corner of grantees land; thence east along the land heretofore conveyed to
grantees 105 feet to the point of beginning .

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD Unto the said Robert E. Jewell and Willie Mae Jewell

as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, their heirs and assigns, forever; it being the intention of the parties to this conveyance, that (unless the joint tenancy hereby created is severed or terminated during the joint lives of the grantees herein) in the event one grantee herein survives the other, the entire interest in fee simple shall pass to the surviving grantee, and if one grantee does not survive the other, then the heirs and assigns of the grantees herein shall take as tenants in common.

And we do, for ourselves and for our heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the said grantees, their heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances.

that we have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that we will, and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantees, their heirs, and assigns forever against the lawful claims of all persons.


