age of twenty-one years, and is capable in every way of conveying real estate by deed.

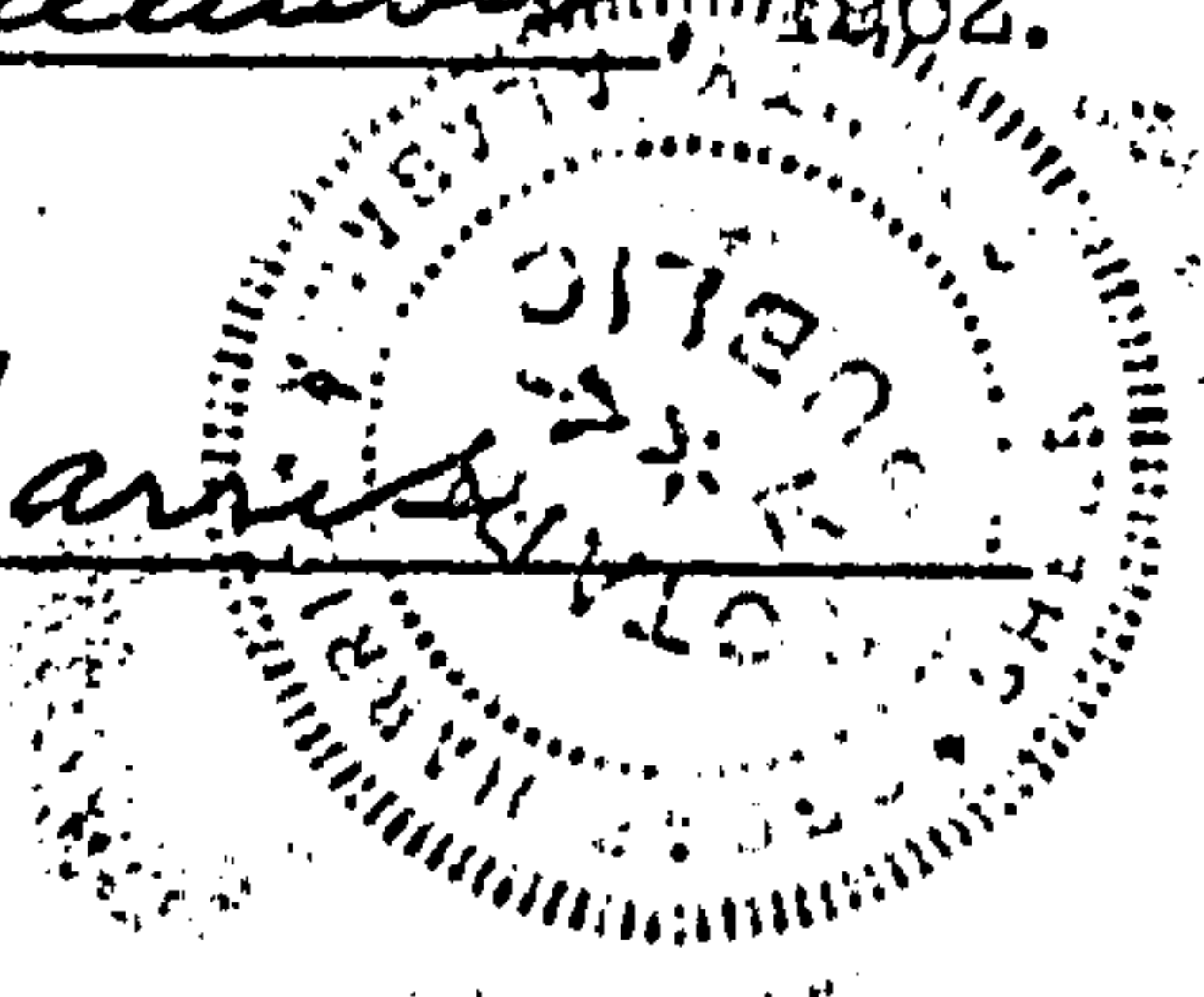
