EXTENSION OF TRUST FOR WILLIAM ALBERT
BELCHER, JR.

This agreement is made and entered into on the 6th day of April, 1955, by and between William Albert Belcher, Jr., and Nell Vandergrift Belcher, as Trustee, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Trustee":

W I T N E S S E T H

THAT WHEREAS heretofore on, to-wit, the 23rd day of December, 1940, William Albert Belcher, Sr. and the aforesaid Nell Vandergrift Belcher, as Trustee for William Albert Belcher, Jr., entered into that certain Indenture and Deed of Trust that was later recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Jefferson County, Alabama on the 27th day of December, 1940 in Volume 3150 Record of Deeds at page 125, and

WHEREAS paragraph 20 of the said Indenture and Deed of Trust provided in part as follows:

"My said son, William Albert Belcher, Jr., shall be the sole beneficiary for whom this trust is created. Upon his arriving at the age of twenty-one years he shall be entitled to, and the trustee shall convey and deliver over to him the entire trust estate including the entire corpus and all accumulated income remaining in the hands of the trustee, and this trust shall be terminated and the trustee discharged pro tanto."

AND WHEREAS, the said William Albert Belcher, Jr., upon his arrival at the age of 21 years on the 5th day of April, 1955, elected not to permit the aforesaid trust to be terminated but elected to have same continued and extended for an additional term of ten years and he is desirous of evidencing his said election to continue and to extend the term of said trust by this written instrument, duly recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Jefferson County, Alabama.

NOW WHEREFORE PREMISES CONSIDERED, I, the said William Albert Belcher, Jr., do hereby make known to all whom this may concern, that I have heretofore elected and do hereby elect to continue in full force and effect under the same terms and conditions and to extend for a term of ten years from the 5th day of April, 1955 and from time to time thereafter as I may elect by written instrument duly recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Jefferson County, Alabama, that certain trust that was created for my benefit on the 23rd day of December, 1940, as evidenced by Indenture and

Deed of Trust recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Jefferson County, Alabama on the 27th day of December, 1940 in Volume 3150 Record of Deeds at page 125, and, I, the said William Albert Belcher, Jr., do hereby ratify and confirm all actions and deeds of the said Nell Vandergrift Belcher, as Trustee under said Indenture and Deed of Trust since her acceptance of said Trusteeship on the 23rd day of December, 1940, and I do further hereby confirm and make known the fact that the Trustee under said Indenture and Deed of Trust, during the period of ten years from and after the 5th day of April, 1955, has had, shall have, and is hereby given, all of the rights, powers and duties in the administration of the Trust Estate covered by said Indenture and Deed of Trust, as she had during the period from the 23rd day of December, 1940 to and including the 5th day of April, 1955.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, William Albert Belcher, Jr., has hereto affixed his signature and seal and Nell Vandergrift Belcher has executed this agreement, as Trustee as further evicence of her acceptance of said Trusteeship, all on the day and in the
