Sixth. All the rest and residue of the property of which I may die seized and possessed, or to which I may be entitled, including real, personal, and mixed, I grant, give, devise and bequeath unto my wife, largaret H. Shannon.

Seventh. I nominate, constitute, and appoint as executor of this, my last will and tostament, my brother, William Hubert Shannon, and it is my desire that he be not required to give bond for the faithful performance of his duties as such executor. In the event of the death, disability or refusal of William Hubert Shannon to act as executor, I nominate, constitute, and appoint my wife, Margaret H. Shannon, executrix of this my last will and testament, and it is my wish that she be not required to give bond for the faithful performance of her duties as such executrix.
