Last Will and Testament

FRANK M. ALLEN

COUNTY OF BAY

I, FRANK M. ALLEN, of the County of Bay, State of Florida, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament.

I.

I hereby revoke all wills and codicils made by me at any time heretofore.

II.

I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon as practicable after my decease.

III.

I give, devise and bequeath to my wife, Elizabeth S. Allen, provided she shall survive me by thirty (30) days, all my estate, real, personal or mixed, wherever situated, of which I may die seized or possessed, to which I may be or become entitled to have any interest.

IV.

If my wife, Elizabeth S. Allen, shall not survive me by thirty (30) days, then I give, devise and bequeath all my estate, real, personal or mixed, wherever situated, of which I may die seized or possessed, or to which I may be or become entitled to have any interest, to my daughter, Mary Elizabeth Allen.

V.

I appoint my wife, Elizabeth S. Allen, as guardian of my daughter, Mary Elizabeth Allen, in the event my daughter, Mary Elizabeth Allen, has not reached her majority at the time of my death. And if my wife shall not survive me, then I appoint Dempsey J. Barron as guardian of my daughter, Mary Elizabeth Allen, in her place and stead.

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VI.

I appoint my wife, Elizabeth S. Allen, executrix of this my Last Will and Testament.

VII.

I direct that none of the individuals named as executrix, guardian or alternate guardian herein, shall be required to file a bond or other security in any jurisdiction for the faithful performance of their duties.

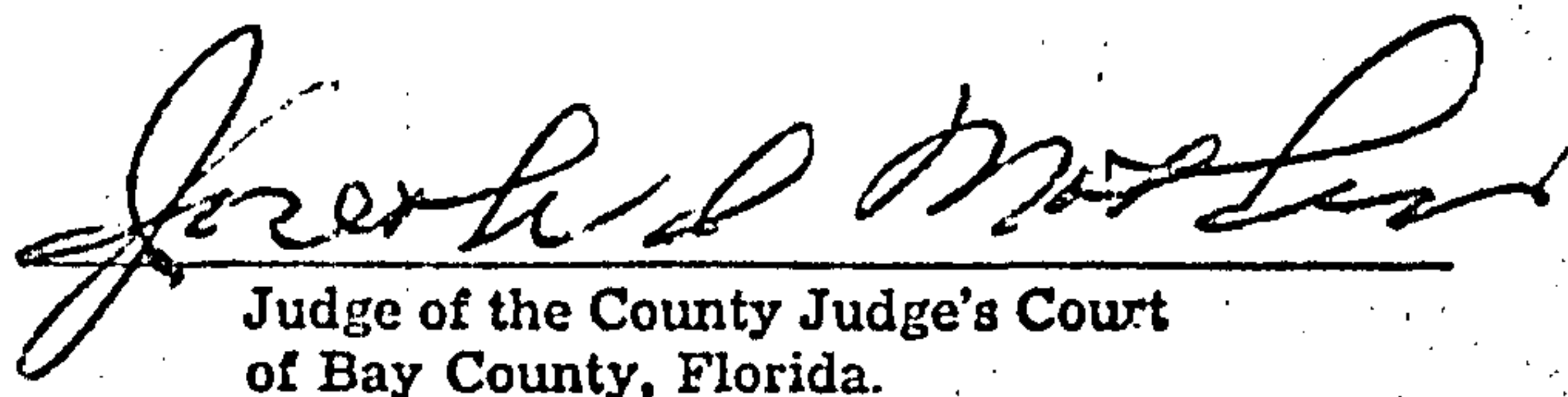

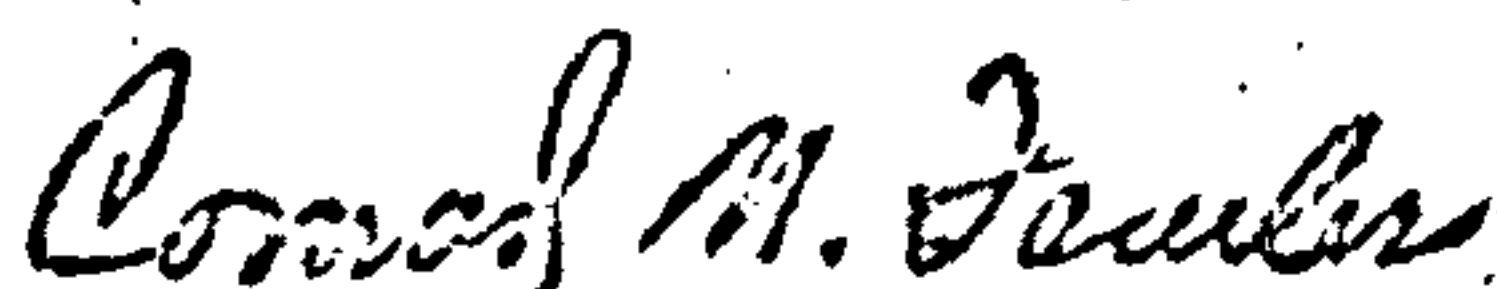
as the same appear^s on file and of record in my office.
