ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the legatee and devisee of said estate is as follows:

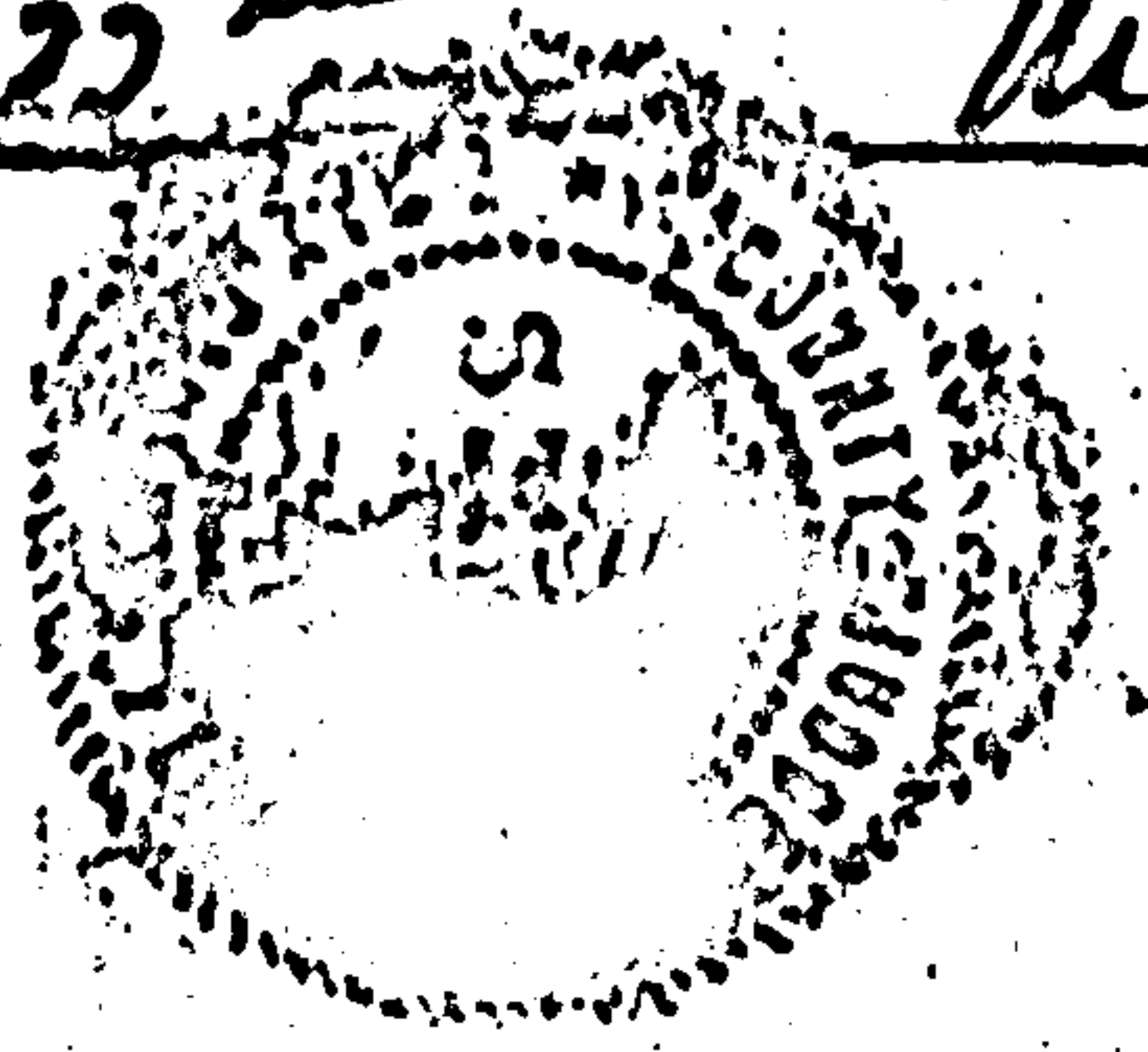
Elizabeth S. Allen, 342 South Palo Alto
