Erwin R. L. Ball and Hassie Odell Ball

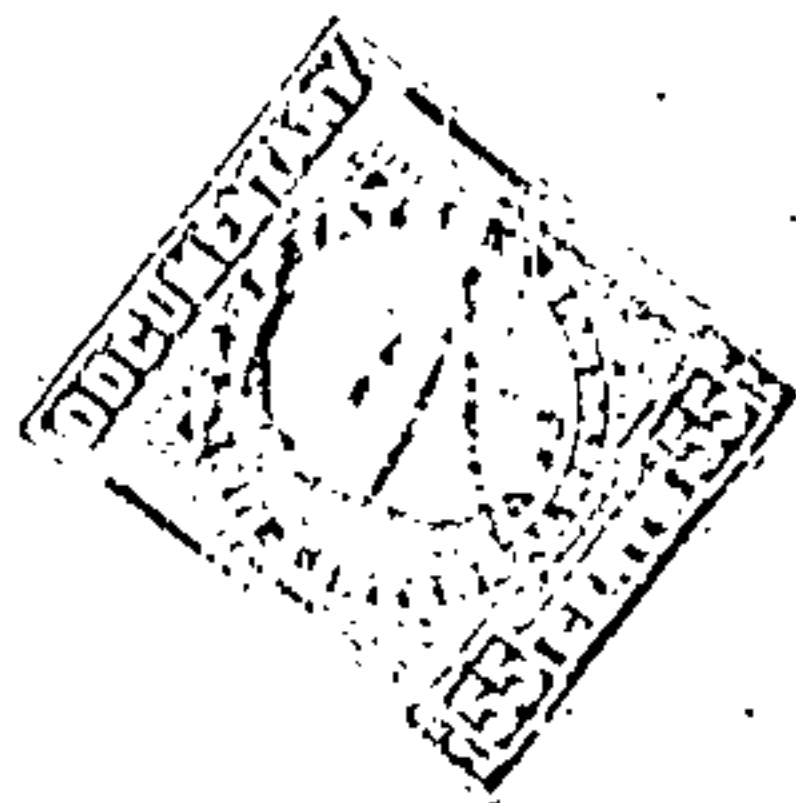
