

MORTGAGE FORECLOSURE DEED



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That Whereas default has been made in the payment of the debt secured by that certain mortgage executed and delivered by Homer Bearden and wife Jeanette Bearden, to Victor Scott, on the 7th day of November, 1961, which said mortgage was recorded in the Office of Judge of Probate for Shelby County, Alabama, in Mortgage Book 276 at page 157; and

WHEREAS, said mortgage provides that on default of the payment of any installment of the indebtedness secured, all of the indebtedness shall become due and payable, and the mortgagee, his heirs or assigns, are authorized to take possession of said property, and may sell the same to the highest bidder, at public auction, at Columbiana, Alabama, for cash, after having advertised such sale in some newspaper published in said county, by two weekly insertions for not less than twenty days, and execute title to the purchaser at said sale, and apply the proceeds to the payment of the expenses incident to said sale, including all costs of collection, taking possession of and caring for said property, and all attorney's fees, and the payment in full of the said demand thereby secured, and pay over the remainder, if any, to the mortgagors, said mortgage also authorizes that the mortgages may buy the property described therein at said sale, and the auctioner crying the same, may execute title to the purchaser; and

WHEREAS, default has been made in payment of note secured by said . mortgage, and there is a balance due on the indebtedness, including principal and interest, of TIMEE NUNDRED TWELVE AND NO/100 DOLLARS; and

WHEREAS, mortgageRelected to foreclose said mortgage, as provided in the terms thereof, and did, on the 19th day of December, 1962 deliver a notice of mortgage foreclosure sale to the Shelby County Reporter, a newspaper published at Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama, and this notice of mortgage foreclosure sale was published in said newspaper for two weekly insertions, to-wit: on December 27, 1962 and January 3, 1963; and

WHEREAS said notice gave the description of the property and the

time and the place of the sale as during the legal hours of sale on January 19. 1963, in front of the Court House door in Columbiana, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, the said W. W. Rabren was selected by said mortgagee as agent and suctioneer to make said sale; and

WHEREAS, 'the said W. W. Rabren, in strict compliance of the powers of sale contained in said mortgage, and pursuant to the terms outlined in said notice, did offer Fox sale, for cash, during the legal hours of sale on January 19, 1963, in front of the Court House door in Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama, the hereinafter described real estate; and
