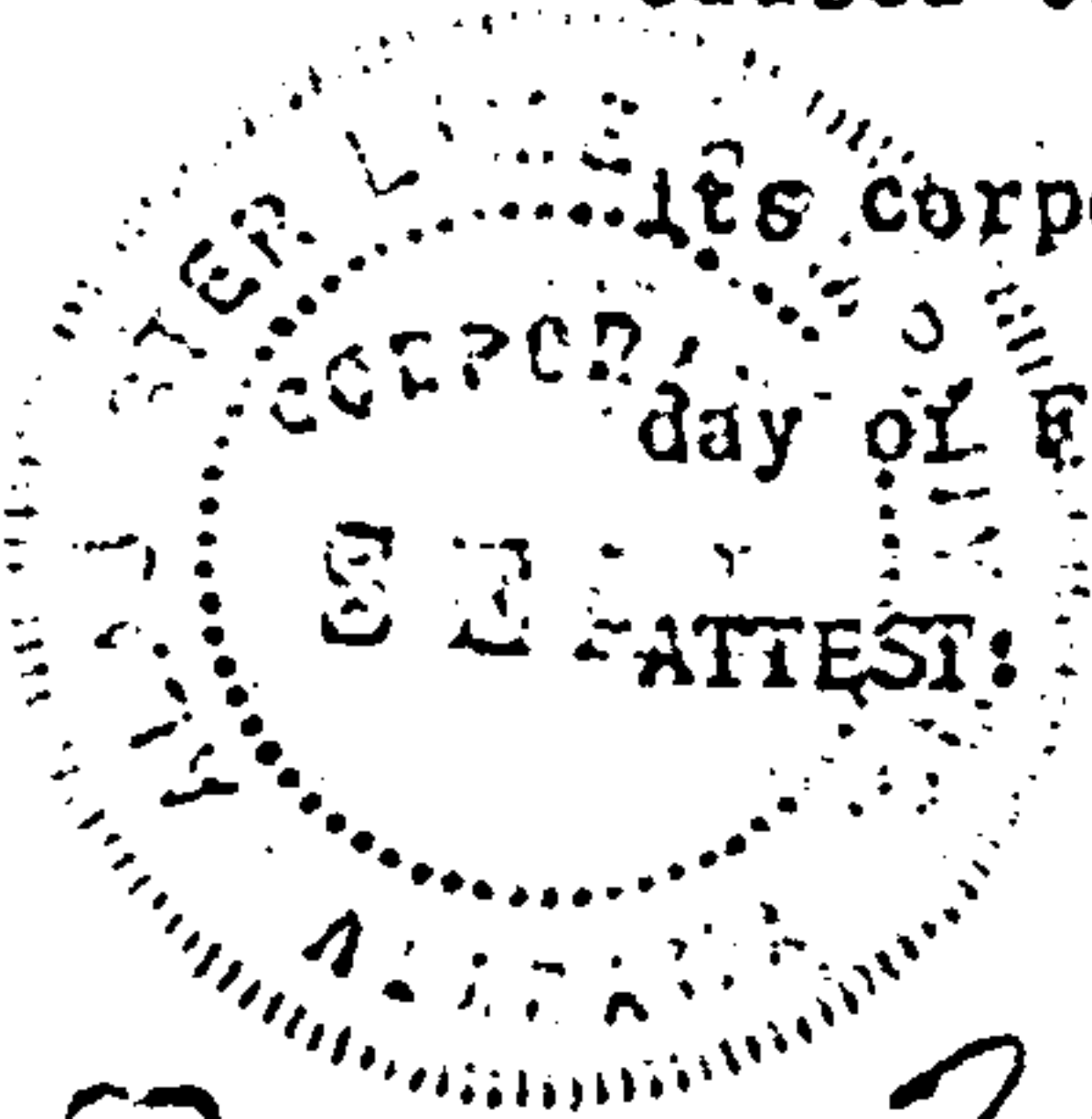

Gray Jones, all its right, title interest and claim in or to the following described real estate, to-wit:

From the Southwest corner of the SE₄ of the NE₄ of Section 35, Township 20 South, Range 3 West run Easterly along the South boundary line of the said SE₄ of the NE₄ of Section 35, Township 20 South, Range 3 West for 284.70 feet to the point of beginning of the land herein described; thence continue Easterly along the South boundary line of the SE₄ of the NE₄ of Section 35, Township 20 South, Range 3 West for 57.90 feet; thence turn an angle of 70 degrees, 33 minutes, 40 seconds to the left and run Northeasterly for 192.0 feet; thence turn an angle of 02 degrees, 05 minutes to the left and run Northeasterly for 175.0 feet; thence turn an angle of 84 degrees, 37 minutes to the right and run Southeasterly for 230.11 feet, more or less, to a point on the West Right of Way line of the South Bound L. & N Railroad; thence turn an angle of 87 degrees, 00 minutes, 15 seconds to the left and run Northeasterly along the West Right of Way line of the South Bound L. & N Railroad for 251.01 feet; thence turn an angle of 88 degrees, 07 minutes to the left and run Northwesterly for 268.36 feet to a point on the East bank of Buck Creek, thence turn an angle of 44 degrees 14 minutes to the left and run Southwesterly up Buck Creek for 287.80 feet; thence turn an angle of 33 degrees, 16 minutes to the left and run Southwesterly up Buck Creek for 246.05 feet; thence turn an angle of 11 degrees, 32 minutes to the left and run Southwesterly up Buck Creek for 170.30 feet to a point on the East bank of Buck Creek; thence turn an angle of 79 degrees, 50 minutes, 50 seconds to the left and run Southeasterly 248.84 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

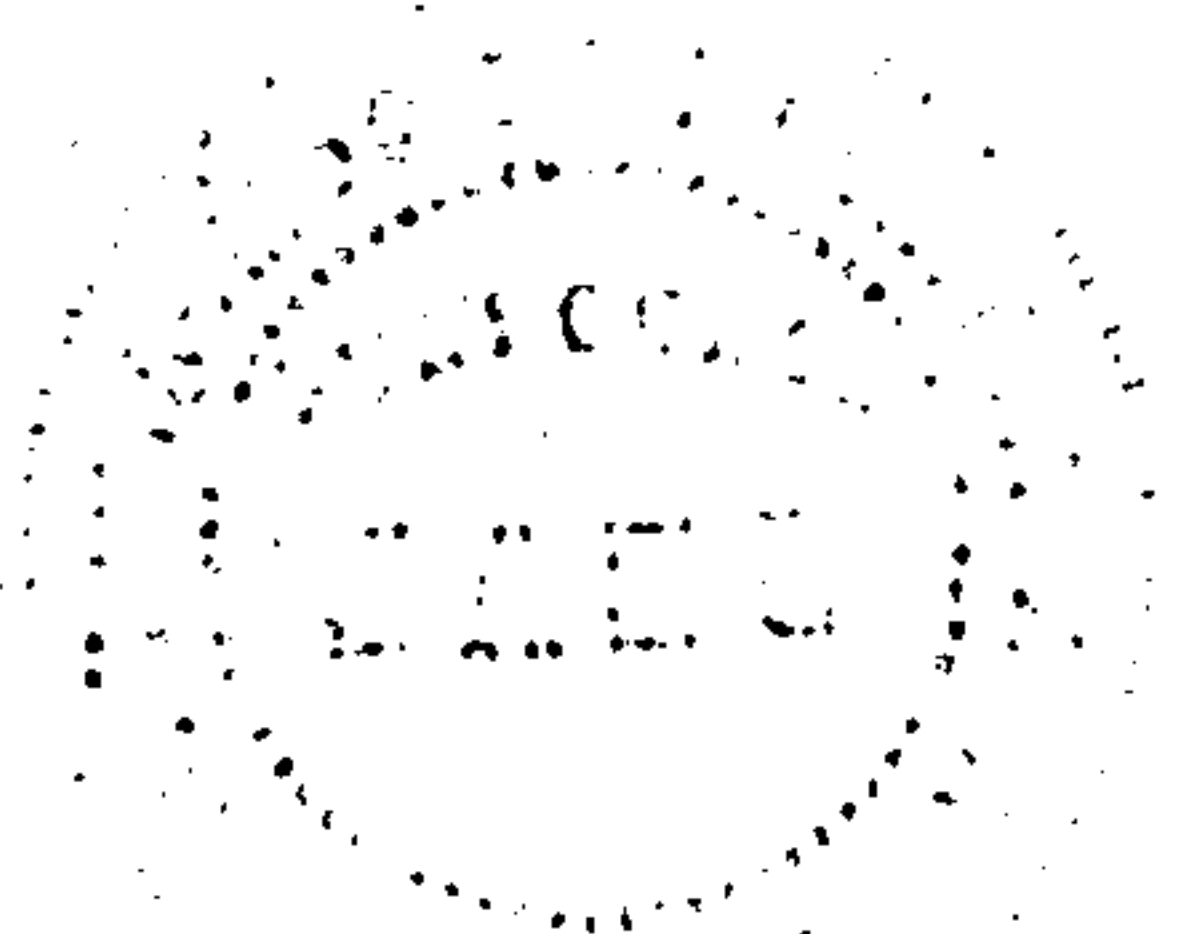
