SALE OF PROPERTY TO J. C. ARMSTRONG

Mr. John Thompson, a member of the Board of Revenue and Control of Shelby County, Alabama, introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption, namely:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Revenue and Control of Shelby County, Alabama, that Shelby County, a body corporate, sell to J. C. Armstrong for the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars the following property, namely:

The W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 21, Range 1 East, Shelby County, Alabama, containing 20 acres, more or less.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that L. C. Walker, Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, be and he is hereby authorized to execute a deed conveying said property to said J. C. Armstrong, to be attested by Cecil Duke, Clerk of said Board.

Fred McClendon, a member of said Board, seconded said motion for the adoption of said resolution, and the same being submitted to a vote, all members of the Board voted in favor of same except Mr. Offie Stinson. Thereupon, L. C. Walker, Chairman or presiding officer of said meeting declared said motion carried and said resolution adopted.
