For and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Twenty Thousand and no/100 (\$120,000.00) Dollars, Forty Thousand and no/100 (\$40,000.00) Dollars of which has been paid in cash, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the balance of Eighty Thousand and no/100 (\$80,000.00) Dollars represented by a promissory note and mortgage, the undersigned Shelby Stone Company, Inc., an Alabama corporation, (hereinafter referred to as the Seller) does hereby sell, transfer and convey unto Alabama Asphaltic Limestone Company, Inc., an Alabama corporation, (hereinafter referred to as the Purchaser:

- (1) All of the equipment, physical assets and personal property described in the list hereto attached, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if though fully set out herein.
- (2) All other personal property of the Seller located in and on its quarry and the lands leased to it, including any and all office equipment and any other personal property, whatever its kind, nature or description, EXCEPTING only (a) inventory of finished limestone rock on the said premises as at the date of this bill of sale, and (b) one Euclid 12-ton hauling unit, one Koehring 605 dragline, one D-8 bulldozer and one LD-5 scoopmobile.

And the Seller warrants to the Purchaser that it has good and merchantable title to each and all the said items of personal property hereby sold to the Purchaser; that the same are free and clear of liens or encumbrances of any nature whatsoever, and agrees to defend, at its own expense and cost, the claim of any person, firm or corporation of any right, title or interest in or to any of the said property herein sold to the Purchaser.
