I am the mother of L. E. Maddox, being one and the same as Edmond Maddox, to whom William S. Brashier and wife, Susie Mae Brashier, gave certain mortgages; one of which was dated January 24, 1950, for the principal amount of Two Hundred Twenty-four and no/100 Dollars, recorded in Mortgage Book 211 page 573 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and another mortgage which was dated January 18, 1952, for the principal amount of Four Hundred Forty-eight and no/100, recorded in Mortgage Book 221 page 281 in said Probate Office.

Affiant further says that the said L. E. Maddox died in the year 1957 without leaving a Will and that there has been no administration of his destate.

Affiant further says that she knows of her own knowledge that said mortgages were paid in full before L. E.
