NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the premises, I, George L. Scott, Sr. do hereby sell, assign, transfer, set-over and deliver to my wife, Annie W. Scott, all such right, title, interest and claim in and to any and all indebtedness now or hereafter owing to me by Alabaster Lime Co., Inc., as will vest title to such indebtedness in myself and Annie W. Scott, jointly, with right of survivorship; it being my intention to hereby transfer and assign said indebtedness to George L. Scott, Sr. and Annie W. Scott, and to the survivor of them.
