LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF JESSIE W. BLACK

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, JESSIE W. BLACK, now residing at Walker's Chapel, Jefferson County, Alabama, being over the age of twenty-one years, and of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this instrument to be my last will and testament. I hereby expressly revoke all former wills and codicils by me at any time heretofore made.

ITEM ONE.

I hereby direct that all of my just debts and funeral expenses, including a suitable monument over my grave, be fully paid by my executor or executors, hereinafter named, with all convenient speed.

ITEM TWO.

I bequeath to my son, Sam Creswell Black, the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00); and to my grandson, Sam Creswell Black, Jr., the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00).

ITEM THREE.

I give, devise and bequeath all of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal and mixed, whatsoever and wheresoever, to my three daughters, Louise B. Cleve, Rowena B. Barclift, and Jessie B. Rea, share and share alike.

ITEM FOUR.

I hereby nominate, designate, constitute and appoint W. C. Barclift and C. A. Rea, jointly, or the survivor among them, if either should predecease me, as executors of this, my last will and testament, and in the event either shall die in my lifetime, or

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should either refuse or be unable to act, then I nominate, designate, constitute and appoint the survivor of them to act and serve as executor individually.

ITEM FIVE.

I hereby authorize and empower my executor, or executors, for the time being of this, my last will and testament, if and whenever in the settlement of my estate they shall deem it advisable to sell at private or public sale, at such price as they shall think fit, the whole or any part of my real and personal estate, and to execute good and sufficient deed and other instruments necessary or proper to convey and transfer the same to the purchaser; and to mortgage upon such terms and conditions as they may think fit, all or any part of my real estate, and to pay all debts and liabilities claimed to be owing by me or my estate upon such evidence as they shall think proper, and to satisfy all debts and liabilities claimed to be owing to me or my estate for such sums, and upon such terms of payment and security as they shall see fit, and to accept any composition therefor, and to compromise, submit to arbitration, and settle all accounts, matters, and differences relating to my estate, and generally to act in the premises as they shall deem expedient without being answerable for any loss occasioned thereby. I further authorize or empower my executor or executors to wind up all of my business affairs without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby, and in winding up said business to pay, compound, or submit to arbitration, all accounts, debts, or other sums due or owing, upon such evidence as to my executor or executors, may seem satisfactory, and to sell upon credit and give time for payment, with or without taking security therefor, all assets of said business for such price or prices, and upon such terms as my executor or executors, may think fit, and generally, to enter into and do all such agreements, releases, and acts as may be necessary to wind up the same in the manner most beneficial to my estate. It is my will, and I further direct
