(herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto

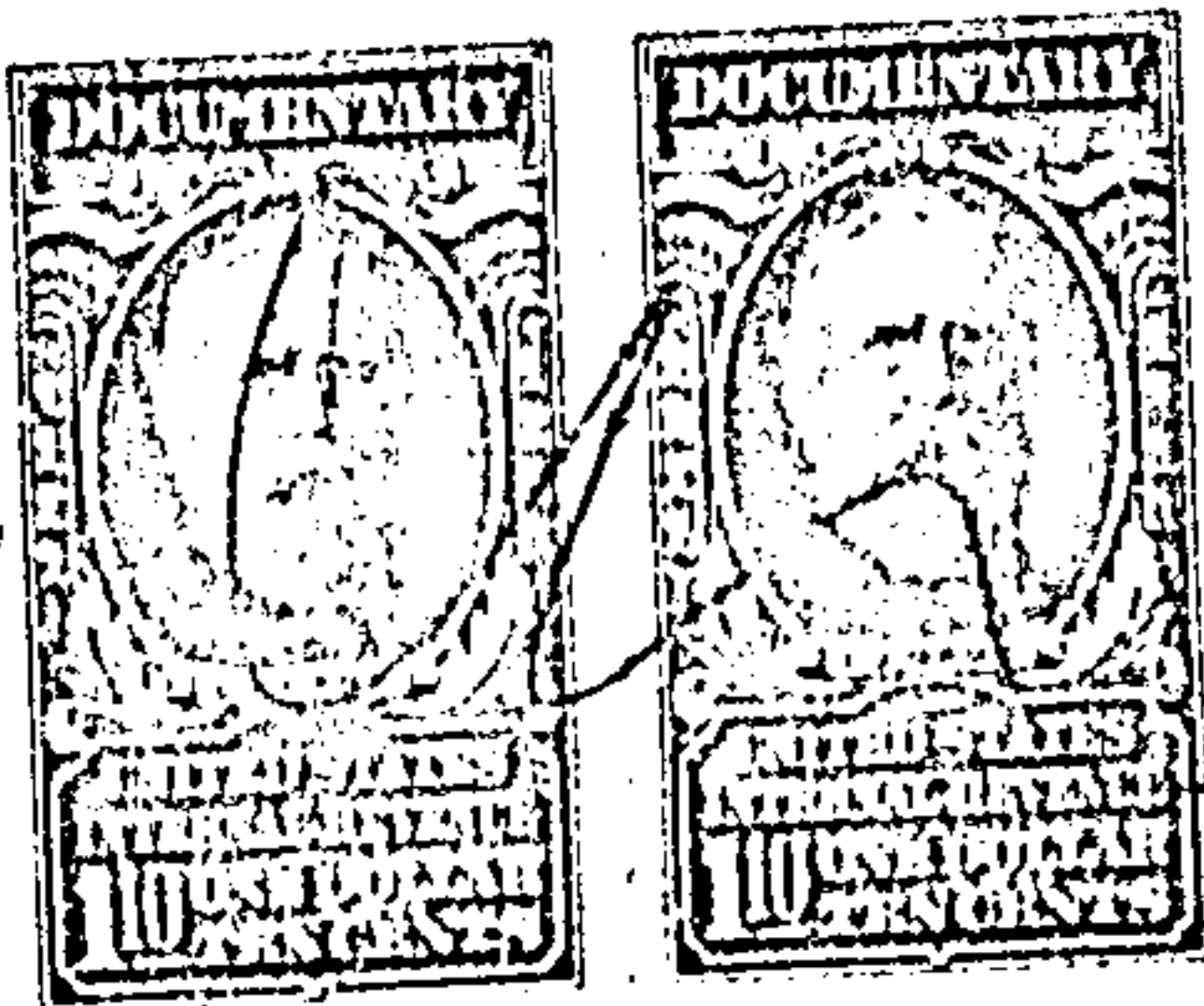
Noah Hosmer and wife, Jessie Mae Cranford Hosmer
