WE, JAMES L. BOLTON AND WIFE PEGGY JOYCE BOLTON
for and in consideration of the sum of ONE OO/100 Dollars
in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over, under
and across the sollowing described lands situated in SHSLABY
Commence at the northwest corner of Section 6, Township 21, Range 2 East and run north 89 degrees 30 minutes east along the section line for 660 feet; thence run south degrees 37 minutes west for 660 feet; thence run north 89 degrees 30 minutes east along the westerly right of way line of Alabama Highway for 313.20 feet, more or less, to the westerly right of way line of Alabama Highway for thence turn right forming an exterior angle of 147 degrees 03 minutes and run 66 feet across said highway right of way to the northernmost corner of the Basil Smith lot; thence continue in the same direction along the northeasterly line of said Smith lot 210.14 feet to the easternmost corner of said Smith lot; thence turn 90 degrees left and run 257 feet to the easternmost corner of he B. D. Beavers lot which is the point of beginning of the land herein described; thence continue in the same direction to the southwesterly line of Spearman Street; thence run northwesterly along same to the southwesterly line of Alabama Highway #25; thence along same in a southwesterly direction 200 feet, more or left, to the northernmost corner of said Beavers lot; thence southeasterly along said Beavers lot. The above described land is the same as that conveyed by Iris Spearman Morton and
Muriel Spearman Hill to James Lewis Rolton and wife, Peggy Bolton, by deed dated
March 11, 1963, and recorded in Deed Book 225, page 48, in the Office of the Judge
of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama.

In the event it becomes necessary or desirable for Alabama Power Company to move its lines of poles, towers and appliances in connection with the construction or improvement of any public road or highway in proximity to its said power lines, the said Company is hereby granted the right to relocate its said lines of poles, towers, and appliances on lands of grantors hereinabove described, provided, however, the said Company shall relocate its said line of poles or towers at a distance not greater than ten feet outside the boundary of the right of way of any such public road or highway as established or re-established from time to time.
Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
