KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Muriel Spearman Hill ^{a widow} and Iris Spearman Morton, ^{a widow}

for and in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 -- -- -- -- -- Dollars (\$ 1.00), to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to implant, install and maintain anchor of wood or other material at one point on the property hereinafter described, and to construct, extend and maintain guy wires from said anchor to structures now erected or hereafter to be erected on said land. Said anchor and guy wires to be located on and across lands of the undersigned in the County of Shelby, State of Alabama:

The lands on which said anchor and guy wires are to be implanted or installed are described as follows:

One guy wire to be situated adjacent to Highway 25 on the following land: Commence at the northwest corner of Section 6, Township 21, Range 2 East and run east along north line of said Section 6 a distance of 660 feet; thence run south 0 degrees 37 minutes west a distance of 660 feet; thence run north 89 degrees 30 minutes east a distance of 313:20 feet, more or less, to the westerly right of way line of Alabama Highway 25; thence run northeasterly along the westerly right of way line of said Highway 25 a distance of 257 feet to a point of beginning; thence turn 90 degrees left and run a distance of 25 feet; thence turn 90 degrees right and run a distance of 50 feet; thence turn 90 degrees right and run a distance of 25 feet to the westerly right of way line of said Highway 25; thence run southwesterly along said right of way line a distance of 50 feet to point of beginning. If said guy wire interferes with any future development on said land the grantee will relocate said guy wire so as not to interfere with said development and permission is herein granted to so relocate said guy wire on the above described land.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
