### FINAL DECREE

This cause coming on to be heard on the original bill of complaint as amended and the respondents answer, the parties having reached an agreement in open court, the court is of the opinion that the complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for and as agreed to by the parties,

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the road prayed for be and it is hereby declared to be a public road, that said road is more specifically described as follows:

Begin at the Southeast corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 24, Range 13 East, and run thence West 210 feet to a point which is the West boundary line of a 210 foot wide strip of land; run thence North along the West boundary line of said 210 foot wide strip of land to the South boundary line of a Black Top Road; run thence East along the South boundary line of said Black Top Road 25 feet to a point; run thence South and parallel with said West boundary line of said 210 foot wide strip of land to a point which is 35 feet North of the South boundary line of said quarter-quarter Section; turn thence left in an arc to a point which is 35 feet East of the West boundary line of said 210 foot wide strip of land and 25 feet North of the South boundary line of said quarter-quarter Section; run thence East and parallel with the South boundary line of said quarter-quarter Section 200 feet to a point which point will be 25 feet East of the West boundary line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 24, Range 13 East; run thence South 25 feet to the South boundary line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 24, Range 13 East; run thence West 25 feet to point of beginning, being a part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 24, Range 13 East, in Shelby County, Alabama.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the respondents, their heirs and assigns, shall have the right to install cattle guards to facilitate the passage of cattle from the lands presently owned by them to adjacent lands lying south and west of said property now owned by respondents.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the respondents be, and they are hereby directed to remove the gate and other barriers previously installed across the north entrance of said road to permit free ingress and egress to, upon and over said road, and the roadway described in the bill of complaint is hereby declared abandoned except as the same is included in the above description of the road.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the costs be taxed against the respondent for which let execution issue.
