the receipt whereof is acknowledged the said

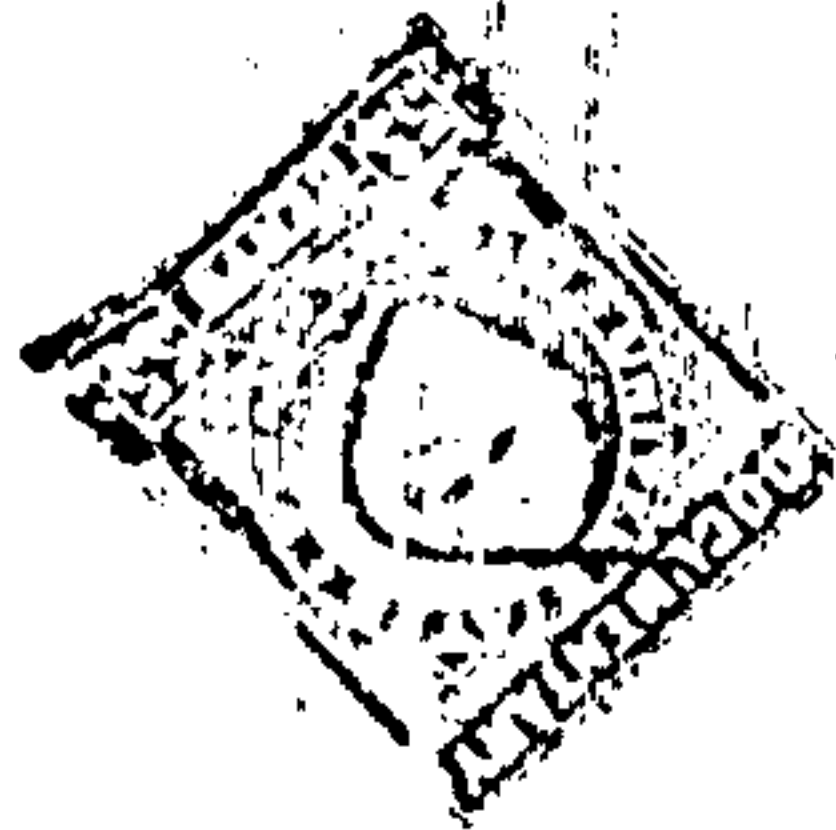

that they are free from all encumbrances;

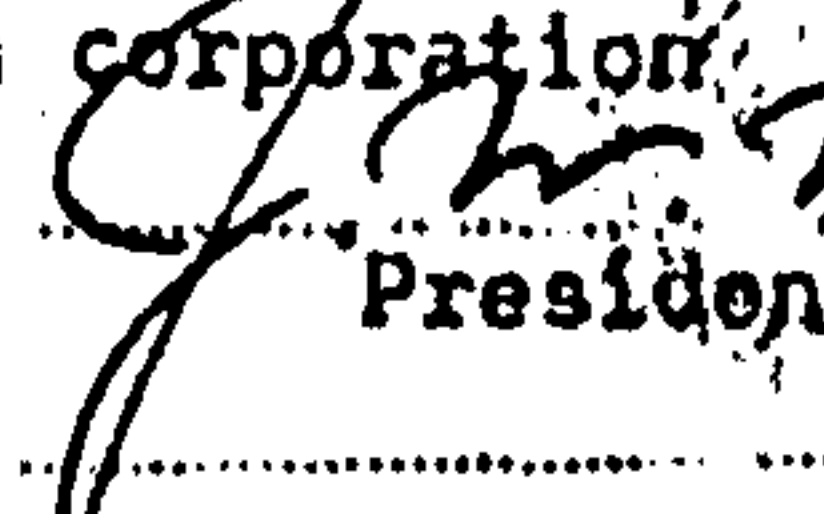
