Carden, Alton Eugene Carden and Lucretia Carden do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Longview Lime Corporation the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to wit:

3.1 acres more or less in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, Section 8, Township 21 South, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama, being more particularly described as follows: Begin at the Northeast corner of said Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 8 and run thence West along the North line of said forty a distance of 525 feet to the point of beginning of the lot herein conveyed and from said point of beginning run South 450 feet; thence West 300 feet; thence North 450 feet to the North line of said forty; thence East along said forty line to point of beginning.

If Grantors are prevented by acts of God from removing said improvements from said land, the said thirty day period shall, on Grantors written request, be extended for a period of time equal to that for which Grantors are so prevented.


