Second:- As to such estate as it hath pleased God to intrust me with, I dispose of the same as follows:-

I give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Virginia Longshore, all my property, real, personal or mixed, of which I may die seized and possessed or to which I may be entitled at the time of my death.

Third:- I hereby nominate and appoint my said wife, Virginia Longshore, sole executrix of this my last will and testament and I direct that she be not required to give any bond for the faithful performance of her duties under this will.
