

Permit—Pole Line, Etc.

Me, George W. Chace, and wife Irene R. Chace, J.A.
Chace and wife Dorothy S. Chace, and B.G. Chace

for and in consideration of the sum of ONE 00/100 Dollars
(\$ 1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is
acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct,
operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by
the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to
string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations
and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over, under and across the following described lands
situated in Shelby County, Alabama: The West Half

of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Township 19N,
Range 3 West.

In the event grantors or their heirs or assigns shall
desire to subdivide said property, or shall desire to erect
improvements thereon, then upon written notice of their intent
so to do, grantors agree to relocate its said power lines, poles
and appliances erected on said property under this easement,
so as to conform to said proposed subdivision or
improvement, at grantors' expense, or otherwise, this easement
at the option of the then owners of said property, or the trustee,
shall upon 60 days written notice to the other party cease and
terminate as if no longer stated that the remaining pole, towers and
lines are to be removed, and the trustee will
provide easement on his property for the relocated line.

In the event it becomes necessary or desirable for Alabama Power Company to move its lines of poles, towers and
appliances in connection with the construction or improvement of any public road or highway in proximity to its
said power lines, the said Company is hereby granted the right to relocate its said lines of poles, towers and ap-
pliances on lands of grantors hereinabove described, provided, however, the said Company shall relocate its said
lines of poles or towers at a distance not greater than ten feet outside the boundary of the right of way of any such
public road or highway as established or re-established from time to time.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including
the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep
clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
