
the receipt whereof is acknowledged we the said Guy N. Cupp and wife, Caroline K. Cupp

Begin at the SW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 24 North, Range 13 East and run North along the West line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ section a distance of 241.42 ft. to the South R.O.W. line of County Highway #17, thence turn an angle of 53 deg. 43 min. to the Right and run along the South margin of said Road a distance of 247.29 ft., thence turn an angle of 10 deg. 15 min. to the Right and run along the South margin of said Road a distance of 70.0 ft., thence turn an angle of 115 deg. 59 min. to the Right and run a distance of 431.38 ft. to the South line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ section, thence turn an angle of 92 deg. 52 min. to the Right and run West along the said section line a distance of 262.07 ft. to the point of beginning.
