## WARRANTY DEED (Joint with Right of Survivorship)

## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That whereas, the undersigned grantors herein are all of the children (heirs at law) of W. M. Burgin, deceased, and his wife. Clara Maud Burgin, deceased, except T. M. Burgin, the grantee herein, and Elbert Burgin,

That W. M. Burgin, deceased, died intestate in Shelby County, Alabama, on to-wit: May 17, 1955, and was at the time of his death seized and possessed of the lands herein described,

That the widow of W. M. Burgin, deceased, Clara Maud Burgin, died testate in Shelby County, Alabama on to-wit:
April 8, 1962, and that no part of said lands were ever set apart to her as a homestead or dower,

That there are no outstanding unpaid claims or debts owing by either of said estates.

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of TWENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED, SIXTY-FOUR & 57/100 DOLLARS (\$27,564.57) to the undersigned grantors, J. 

Part of Sections 10 and 11, Township 22 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama, said part being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the north line of Section 11 and the west line of the right-of-way of the Montevallo-Ashville Road, run thence west along the north line of Sections 11 and 10 for 2,634.4 feet to a fence, thence S 13 degrees, 11 minutes W, more or less, and along said fence, for 2,700.9 feet to a point which is fifteen feet north of the center of Quinn Lane, thence S 66 degrees, 42 minutes E, and parallel with, and fifteen feet north of, the center line of Quinn Lane, for 641.5 feet to the west line of said Montevallo-Ashville Road, thence northeasterly along the west line of said Montevallo-Ashville Road for 4,102 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning; except a parcel containing one acre, more or less, located in the northeast corner of said property and fronting 150 feet on the Montevallo-Ashville Road, and extending west along the north line of said Section 11 for 300 feet; together with all improvements and appurtenances thereunto appertaining. Containing 112.3 acres, more or less, in fee simple.

No part of the above described real estate is the homestead of grantors.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD Unto the said T. M. Burgin and Ellen Virginia Burgin, as joint tenants, with right of survivorship,

their heirs and assigns, forever; it being the intention of the parties to this conveyance, that (unless the joint tenancy hereby created is severed or terminated during the joint lives of the grantees herein), in the event one grantee herein survives the other, the entire interest in fee simple shall pass to the surviving grantee, and if one grantee does not survive the other, then the heirs and assigns of the grantees herein shall take as tenants in common.

And we do, for ourselves and for our heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the said grantees, their heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances; that we have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that we will, and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantees their heirs, and assigns forever against the lawful claims of all persons.
